SUBJECT: Sacramento Trapshooting Club Lease

SUMMARY

The current lease for the Sacramento Trapshooting Club expires on February 28, 1982. Pursuant to Chapter 12, Article 2, Section 12.39 of the City Code and City Council direction received on February 16, 1982, the terms of a new lease have been negotiated with the Sacramento Trapshooting Club.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Sacramento Trapshooting Club has used City-owned facilities and a portion of Del Paso Park since 1927. The property has been leased, rather than being put out on a concession contract, in the interest of keeping the cost of operations, and consequently the prices, to a minimum for the public. The Sacramento Trapshooting Club, a nonprofit organization, has always operated the facility in keeping with that interest.

Section 8, items f-i, has been negotiated to provide additional services to the public at no direct cost to the City.

f. Lessee shall provide, twice a year, paid advertisement (2" X 1 3/8" column) publicizing shooting days and hours for the public. The advertising will be in one of the two major local newspapers.

g. Lessee shall advertise public Hunter Safety Classes in the two major local newspapers and in local sport shops and Hunting License agencies.
