

Sacramento, California,

October 29, 1932.

The Civil Service Board of the City of Sacramento met in special session on the above date at twelve-twenty o'clock P. M. in the office of the Board, Room 106 City Hall, President Weisman presiding.

PRESENT: Commissioners Chenu, Deise, and Weisman.
ABSENT : None.

In the absence of the Secretary, Mr. Harold P. Norton, Mrs. Dadd was appointed Secretary protem.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as read.

Mr. J. B. Maloney, Superintendent of Recreation, appeared before the Board and explained in detail his position with regard to the appointment of laborers for the Sacramento Golf Course from the eligible list. He stated that these men were hired originally by Mr. Hunter, the contractor who constructed the golf course for the city, that they were thoroughly familiar with the work of the course, and due to the fact that the course is not completed it was to the best interests of the city that they continue in their present work for a period of time. Mr. Maloney stated that Mr. Dillon and Mr. Thompson had been returned to the eligible list and that he would request the Civil Service Board to supply men to take their places.

Upon motion by Commissioner Chenu, seconded by Commissioner Deise, and unanimously carried, the Secretary was instructed to obtain an opinion from the City Attorney with regard to Section 165 of the City Charter, as pertaining to employees working for

the city and living outside the City Limits.

Upon motion by Commissioner Chenu, seconded by Commissioner Deise, and unanimously carried, the Secretary was instructed to prepare an examination to be held for Supervisor of Recreation as soon as possible.

Upon motion by Commissioner Deise, seconded by Commissioner Chenu, and unanimously carried, the Board postponed the examinations for Watchman and Elevator Operator indefinitely.

It was moved by Commissioner Deise, seconded by Commissioner Chenu and unanimously carried that the dates for the examination for the classifications of Senior Clerk, Stenographer, Telephone Operator, Auto Mechanic, Machinist, Machinist Helper, and Janitor be ~~laid over until the next meeting.~~ *postponed indefinitely, Min. C.S.B. 12-16-32*

Adjournment was taken at one-thirty o'clock P. M. to meet again at the call of the Chair.
