RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 3200

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, public interest and convenience require the abandonment and vacating of the Street hereinafter described, as provided under the Street Vacation Act of 1941, Streets and Highways Code of the State of California.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Sacramento hereby declares its intention to abandon and vacate the following described Street:

All that portion of 54th Street lying between a point located 100.00 feet Southerly of 22nd Avenue and the Southerly Boundary of Amended Plat No. 1 of Colonial Heights (as the same is shown on the official Plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder), in the City of Sacramento.

Said Street is shown on a Plat on file in the office of the Clerk of the City Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the 25th day of April, 1957, at the hour of eight o'clock P. M., in the Council Chamber of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, on I Street between 9th and 10th Streets in said City, be, and the same is hereby affixed as the time and place for the hearing of the proposed abandonment of said Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk be directed to publish Notice of Hearing of the proposed abandonment of said Street, in the Sacramento Union, a daily newspaper as required by Law, and that said Notice be posted along said Street to be abandoned in accordance with the provisions of the Street
