**AWARD CONTRACT FOR THE STOCKTON BOULEVARD WATER TRANSMISSION
MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT- R STREET TO 2ND AVENUE (PN: ZL41)**

BACKGROUND

- A. The existing riveted steel main in Stockton Boulevard from R Street to 2nd Avenue is corroding and deteriorating. This project replaces 5,300 feet of 20-inch riveted steel main.
- B. City staff has prepared a set of plans and specifications to replace the existing riveted steel transmission main with a new 24-inch diameter transmission main to improve reliability and safety. The project was advertised for bidding and bids were received on February 28, 2007.
- C. T&S Construction Co., Inc. was the lowest responsible bidder. Due to the correction of a math error in the bid submitted by T&S Construction Co., Inc., their bid has an ESBE participation level of 19.8% rather than 20%. This discrepancy of 0.2% is waived as a minor irregularity.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The contract plans and specifications for the Stockton Boulevard Water Transmission Main Replacement Project – R Street to 2nd Avenue (PN: ZL41) are approved, and the contract is awarded to T&S Construction Co., Inc., for an amount not to exceed \$2,116,932.
