

Sacramento, California.

August 28, 1929.

The Civil Service Board of the City of Sacramento met in special session on the above date at 7:10 o'clock P.M. in their office, Room 106 City Hall, President Chenu presiding.

PRESENT: Commissioners Weisman, Mason, and Chenu.

ABSENT : None.

The minutes of the special meeting of July 25, 1929, were read and approved as read.

Immediately after the meeting convened the President of the Board, Mr. Charles J. Chenu, handed to the Secretary a communication from Mr. Peter J. Wilkie, Attorney-at-Law, Commissioner Chenu stating that the communication was received by him from Mr. Wilkie between the hours of 2:00 and 4:00 o'clock P.M. on Monday, August 26th. The Secretary proceeded to read the communication to the members of the Civil Service Board. This communication concerned the employment of the following men in the positions now held by them and the right to such position under the Charter and the Civil Service Rules, and the payment of their salaries: W. A. Carroll, Raymond M. LeLong, Henry W. Hunger, L. B. Kiernan, Robert J. Patterson, Royal E. Davis, Dr. D. B. Boyd, Harry W. Culbertson. The communication also mentioned the present status of H. W. Culbertson and maintained that he is not rightfully employed.

Upon motion by Commissioner Mason, seconded by Commissioner Weisman, and unanimously carried, the Secretary was instructed to take this communication with the entire files relating to those men mentioned in the communication to the City Attorney and to obtain a written opinion.

Upon motion by Commissioner Mason, seconded by Commissioner Weisman, and unanimously carried the Secretary was instructed to obtain a written opinion with regard to the legality of Dr. D. B. Boyd and Owen Orr being employed by the City and not residing therein.

The Board also desired an opinion from the City Attorney as to the liability of the Civil Service Board for the acts of their predecessors.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 8:00 o'clock P.M. to meet again Thursday evening, August 29, 1929.
