SUBJECT: Appeal of Jack Freels, Capitol Coin Vending from the decision of the Chief of Police

SUMMARY

Attached is the appeal of Jack Freels, Capitol Coin Vending, from the decision of the Chief of Police, as required by Section 5.74 of the Sacramento City Code.

Under Sections 2.323 and 2.324 of the City Code, the Council may appoint a hearing examiner to hear the appeal if it finds that "the appeal may involve a lengthy factfinding process which would be more appropriately accommodated by a formal hearing before a hearing examiner."

FINANCIAL DATA

The estimated cost would be \$100.00 and would be available from the Chief of Police's budget.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. If the Council should decide to appoint a hearing examiner, it is recommended that the following motion be adopted: "The Council hereby determines pursuant to Section 2.324, City Code, that this appeal will involve a lengthy factfinding process which will be more appropriately accommodated by a formal hearing before a hearing examiner. 
