

ORDINANCE NO. 968, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE DIM-OUT ELECTROLIERS AND TRAFFIC SIGNALS WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to purchase in open market, without first advertising for bids, dim-out electroliers and traffic signals in the manner required by Ordinance No. 966, Fourth Series (Dim-out ordinance), as follows: for electroliers, \$1,200.00; for traffic signals, \$1,300.00; total, \$2,500.00, such course having been recommended by the City Manager.


SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that, under the dim-out ordinance passed by the City Council in pursuance of direction of Lieutenant General De Witt of the United States Army, dim-out shall be accomplished BY November 12 1942, and it is necessary to begin operations at once.
