

RESOLUTION No. 800

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

November 4, 1937

WHEREAS, a consolidated Regular and Special Municipal Election was held in the City of Sacramento on the 2nd day of November, 1937, pursuant to provisions of Ordinance No. 752, Fourth Series adopted by the City Council on date of October 7th, 1937, at which a certain proposed Proposition for the incurring of bonded indebtedness against the City of Sacramento was submitted to the qualified electors of the City of Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, the vote and returns of said election have this day been canvassed by the City Council of the City of Sacramento convening as a Canvassing Board and the results thereof duly ascertained other than the ballots of absentee voters;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND DECLARED that the total number of votes cast by the electors at said election other than the ballots of absentee voters for and against the following Bond Proposition, being the only Bond Proposition submitted to the voters at such election; viz:
