

ORDINANCE NO. 929, FOURTH SERIES.


AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA A HEAVY DUTY GALION POWER GRADER, WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to purchase from the State of California a heavy duty Galion Power Grader at a cost of \$700.00, plus \$21.00 sales tax, without advertising for bids, such course having been recommended by the City Manager.



This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that it is difficult to buy such equipment in the market today at any price and the City can secure this piece of very much needed equipment by private negotiation if it acts before the State advertises it for open bids.
