**SUBJECT:** County of Sacramento FY 1988-89 Funding Support - Sacramento Museum and History Division, Metropolitan Arts Division, and Golden Era Handicrafts

SUMMARY

This report requests authorization to execute separate agreements with the County of Sacramento for their FY 1988-89 support of the Sacramento Museum and History Commission, Sacramento History Center, Sacramento Science Center, Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission, and Golden Era Handicrafts.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Sacramento Museum and History Commission, Sacramento History Center, Sacramento Science Center, and the Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission are supported through joint City-County efforts. Each year, the City and County approve the budgets of these organizations, appropriating funds in the City budget, a portion of which is reimbursed by the County of Sacramento.

The approved city 1988-89 fiscal year budget included county support of:

\$201,856	Sacramento Museum and History Commission
\$154,317	Sacramento History Center Association
\$ 80,210	Sacramento Science Center
\$ 84,362	Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission

On February 2, 1988, City Council approved the transfer of Golden Era Handicrafts from Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency to City Parks and Community Services Waterfront Management. The County of Sacramento committed \$8,000 at that time. The County has again committed \$8,000 to Golden Era Handicrafts for FY 1988-89 operational support.

An agreement between the City and County for each organization is necessary to facilitate this funding support. The agreements reflect the above amounts.

FINANCIAL DATA

Funding support from the County of Sacramento to the Sacramento Museum and History Commission, Sacramento History Center, Sacramento Science Center, Metropolitan Arts Commission, and Golden Era Handicrafts has been included in the city budget for the 1988-89 fiscal year.

RECOMMENDATION


It is recommended that the Budget and Finance Committee approve this report and forward it to the City Council for action. Further, it is recommended that City Council, by resolution, authorize the City Manager to execute agreements with the County of Sacramento for funding support of the Sacramento Museum and History Commission, Sacramento History Center, Sacramento Science Center, Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission, and Golden Era Handicrafts.
