

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-005

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

January 10, 2012

ACCEPTANCE OF ADDITIONAL FUNDING FROM 2010 STATE HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM ("SHSGP").

BACKGROUND

- A. Under Resolution No. 2011-252, Council approved the Sacramento Fire Department to accept \$408,183 in grant funding through the 2010 State Homeland Security Grant Program ("SHSGP") from the State of California Office of Homeland Security and sub-granted through the County of Sacramento Office of Emergency Operations.
- B. The Sacramento Fire Department is seeking approval to accept additional grant funding from the State of California Office of Homeland Security and sub-granted through the County of Sacramento Office of Emergency Services in the amount of \$56,731 through the 2010 SHSGP. If approved, this will increase the total amount awarded and accepted to \$464,914 for the 2010 grant period.
- C. This additional funding is available through de-obligated 2010 monies previously awarded to other agencies and in response to an identified reduction in grant-funded equipment in the 2011 SHSGP period.
- D. The grant funds being made available will provide necessary and advanced training for the region along with necessary supplies and equipment that will help sustain and enhance the response capabilities for the Sacramento region during an emergency situation.
- E. This additional funding will be used to replace the Sacramento Fire Department's damaged Hazardous Material ("HAZMAT") robot.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager or his designees, Fire Chief and Deputy Fire Chief, are individually authorized to accept an additional \$56,731 in grant funding from the 2010 State Homeland Security Grant Program ("SHSGP").
- Section 2. The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to adjust the necessary grant revenue and expenditure budgets to increase the budget by \$56,731 to the new total of \$464,914 and implement the SHSGP grant.
- Section 3. The City Manager, or his designee, Fire Chief and Deputy Fire Chief, is hereby authorized to approve all other paperwork to implement the additional 2010 SHSGP grant funding awarded and to assure adherence to all grant regulations.


