
A RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT VOLUNTEER WORKERS ARE EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO WITH CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS, AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 80-429

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Labor Code Section 3363.5 and for purposes of that section only, a person who performs voluntary services without pay for the City of Sacramento at the express request of an authorized agent of the City is deemed to be an employee of the City for purposes of Part 2, Division 4, of the Labor Code while performing such service.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 1 herein, persons who ride as passengers in City Police vehicles shall not be deemed employees of the City for any purpose whatsoever, except that amateur radio operators who are members of the PUSH Program and who are engaged in that capacity while a passenger in City Police vehicles shall be considered employees of the City for purposes of Section 1 of this Resolution.

3. Resolution No. 80-429 is hereby repealed.
