

RESOLUTION No. 228

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of
September 19, 1929

RESOLUTION APPROVING BOND OF PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY EXECUTED IN CONSIDERATION OF THE GRANT OF THE FRANCHISE TO OPERATE MOTOR BUSES IN THE PUBLIC STREETS, AVENUE AND ROAD OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO.


WHEREAS, on the 12th day of September, 1929, the City Council of the City of Sacramento struck off, sold and awarded to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of California, the franchise of operating motor buses on certain public streets, avenue and road of said City for transportation of passengers; and

WHEREAS, said Pacific Gas and Electric Company pursuant to the provisions of the Charter of the City of Sacramento, has within ten (10) days after the passage of the Ordinance granting said franchise, duly executed, and filed with this Council a bond in the penal sum of five hundred (\$500) dollars bearing date of the 12th day of September, 1929, and conditioned as prescribed by the provisions of said Charter; and

WHEREAS, upon due investigation and consideration, it appears to the satisfaction of this Council that said bond is in proper form and that said bond has been duly executed by said Pacific Gas and Electric Company and by two good and sufficient sureties;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that said bond be and it is hereby accepted and approved.
