

THE HONORABLE CITY COUNCIL,  
CITY OF SACRAMENTO,  
REGULAR MEETING,  
SEPTEMBER 4th,  
1924.

The Honorable City Council met in Regular Session on this date at 8.25 o'clock P. M., Mayor Elkus presiding and Roll Call being answered by following members of City Council:

Anderson, Elkus, Frazier, Goddard, Kiernan, John H. Miller.

The Minutes of Regular Meeting of August 28th, 1924 and Minutes of Special Meeting of August 29th, 1924 were read and approved.

With consent of the Council, the Mayor ordered that the regular tour of the City by members of Council, scheduled for September 5th, be postponed two weeks.

In accordance with recommendation of City Manager, Councilman Kiernan moved that plat of Central Nichols Park, Subdivision, South of City of Sacramento, be approved. Seconded by Mayor Elkus and carried by following vote:

"RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Sacramento, that the Diagram made by the City Engineer as directed by the City Council in its Resolution of Intention No. 1893, which said Diagram shows the District to be assessed to pay the costs and expenses of improving 12th Avenue, in the City of Sacramento, from the center line of 40th Street (south) to the manhole in place 470 feet westerly therefrom, be and the same is hereby approved and the City Clerk is hereby directed to notify the Superintendent of Streets, in writing, of the approval of the said diagram."

In accordance with foregoing recommendation, Councilman Brown moved that foregoing Resolution be adopted. Seconded by Councilman Anderson and carried by following vote:

City Manager presented Map of District to be assessed, plans, resolution establishing grades and Resolution of Intention No. 1923 providing for the improvement of right-of-way between 51st and 52nd Streets from the manhole in place on 2nd Avenue to the manhole in place on V Street, in accordance with standard specifications heretofore adopted by City Council, recommending adoption.

Councilman Anderson thereupon moved that foregoing Map be approved. Seconded by Councilman Bidwell and carried by following vote:

Councilman Anderson thereupon introduced the following Resolution:-

Councilman Anderson moved that foregoing Resolution be adopted. Seconded by Councilman Bidwell and carried by following vote:

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 1923, calling for said improvement by the construction of vitrified ironstone pipe sewer with four inch vitrified ironstone wye branches attached; and constructing concrete manholes complete with cast iron curbs and covers in aforesaid district; setting date of September 25th, 1924 at 9 o'clock P. M., as time for receipt of protests (which Resolution in full appears in Street Work Resolution Record, Volume Two on file in office of City Clerk).

Councilman Anderson moved that foregoing Resolution be adopted. Seconded by Councilman Kiernan and carried by following vote:
