May 7, 1936


RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO FIXING AMOUNT OF DEPOSIT TO BE MADE BY PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY IN CONNECTION WITH ITS APPLICATION TO SAID CITY COUNCIL FOR THE GRANT OF A SUPERSEDING GAS FRANCHISE AS THEREIN MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED.

WHEREAS, Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a California utility corporation, has filed with this City Council its application bearing date the 30th day of April, 1936, for the grant to it by said City Council of a superseding gas franchise as therein more particularly described;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that said applicant be required to deposit with the City Treasurer of said city, either in cash or by certified check payable to said city, the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) as a guarantee of the good faith of applicant and as a fund out of which to pay all expenses incurred by said city connected with said application, including the cost of publication in the event that the said franchise is awarded to applicant or be not awarded at all.
