**SUMMARY:**

Attached is a resolution by which you approve the submission of an application to the Area 4 Agency on Aging for fifth year Title III funding for the Golden Era Handicrafts Cooperative in the amount of \$13,089 and third year Title III funding for the Senior Companion Program (Homebound Component) in the amount of \$37,718. The resolution also authorizes the Executive Director to execute the contract upon approval. The request is for \$50,807 for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 1980.

**BACKGROUND:**

Title III funds from the Comprehensive Older Americans Act amendments of 1978 are received through the Area 4 Agency on Aging. To consolidate efforts there will now be a single contract between the Housing Authority of the City of Sacramento and the Area 4 Agency on Aging for Title III funding of on-going projects previously funded under separate contracts.

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## FINANCIAL DATA:

Of the \$50,807 requested under Title III, the Golden Era Handicrafts Cooperative is budgeted for \$13,087 and the Senior Companion Program (Homebound Component) is budgeted for \$37,718. The requested Title III funds would maintain both projects at their present level while allowing for a 3% cost-of-living increase. No new staffing positions are requested and no City or County funds are required for either project.
