of the City Council

Recognizing "The Community That Cares"

WHEREAS, the City and County of Sacramento received the only \$1.5 million grant from the State Office of Criminal Justice Planning - Title V Grant in June of 1995; and

WHEREAS, *The Community That Cares* was selected as a national award winner by the Local Collaboration for Children and Youth presented through the National League of Cities, the National Association of Counties, the United States Conference of Mayors and the National School Boards Association, in addition to receiving the California Park & Recreation Society Community Service Award; and

WHEREAS, this grant funded *The Community That Cares*, a unique partnership of the City and County of Sacramento, the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency, the North Sacramento, Del Paso Heights, Grant Union School Districts and over 20 diverse non-profit community providers whose collaborative efforts were to prevent juvenile delinquency in the Del Paso Heights/North Sacramento community; and

WHEREAS, the prevention programs that were designed to achieve these strategies included family, school and community and together these clusters involved working partnerships between numerous community organizations, school districts and city and county government; and

WHEREAS, *The Community That Cares* made a commitment to community participation at all levels including involving the community in budget decisions, developing neighborhood and youth leaders, and hiring staff who live in the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Sacramento, that we do hereby congratulate all the community partners and staff who have worked on *The Community That Cares* over the past two years to make this effort truly remarkable.
