RE: OLD SACRAMENTO BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT AREA

Honorable Members in Session:

SUMMARY

This is a request to continue any discussion on the ordinance establishing a business improvement area in Old Sacramento. I would like to continue this matter until March 3, 1981. We need the additional time to attempt to work out differences of opinion on procedure between City staff members and some of the representatives of the Old Sacramento business community.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The City Council on November 25, 1980, asked us to prepare a revision of the Old Sacramento Business Improvement Area Ordinance to provide for greater flexibility in modifications to the district. The Council also asked us to explore a ballot procedure in the establishment and modification of this type of district. We have prepared a draft ordinance complying with the Council's instructions. Under the revised ordinance, the City Clerk would be charged with the responsibility of administering the new procedure. She would like to discuss this procedure in more detail with our office and with business representatives from Old Sacramento. There is no time priority on this matter since there is no immediate interest in forming a new district in Old Sacramento.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that this matter be continued until March 3, 1981.
