

REGULAR MEETING  
SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL  
MAY 3, 1951

The Honorable City Council met in regular session on this date at hour of 8:15 o'clock P. M. President Pro Tem Hendren presiding and roll call was answered by the following members: Councilmen Bahnfleth, Cooledge, Hendren, Macaulay, Sayre, Seymour, Wood. ABSENT: Councilmen Geisreiter, Nielsen.




