COMPLIMENTING COUNCILMAN KLUMPP

WHEREAS the City Council of the City of Sacramento has been greatly complimented and the City benefited by the unselfish, loyal and efficient public service rendered by the Honorable George L. Klumpp as a member of the City Council, and as Mayor of the City of Sacramento; and
