

ORDINANCE NO. 1173, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ANNEXATION OF UNINHABITED CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO TO BE DESIGNATED AS "RIVER PARK".

WHEREAS, on the 26th day of April, 1946, the Council of the City of Sacramento by resolution duly initiated proceedings for the annexation of certain uninhabited contiguous territory to the City of Sacramento to be designated as "RIVER PARK", which said uninhabited contiguous territory is hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, a copy of said resolution was published at least once a week for two successive weeks prior to the hearing of said proceedings in the "SACRAMENTO UNION", a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of Sacramento and the official newspaper of said City of Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, the hour and place for said hearing was set for 8 o'clock P.M. May 17, 1946, at the Council Chamber of the City of Sacramento, in the Sacramento City Hall at 9th and Eye Streets, in the City of Sacramento, California; and

WHEREAS, said hearing was duly held at said time, date and place; and

WHEREAS, at said time, date and place no owner of property within the territory proposed to be annexed had filed written or other protest against said proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, it is to the best interests of the City of Sacramento that said uninhabited contiguous territory be annexed to said City of Sacramento;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That that certain uninhabited contiguous territory situated in the County of Sacramento, in the State of California, and more particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the westerly production of the northerly boundary of that certain 71.25 acre tract of land described in deed executed by W. W. White et al to Henry S. Moddison, dated January 16, 1911, and recorded in the office of the Recorder of Sacramento County on January 16, 1911, in Book 326 of Deeds, at page 433, with the easterly boundary of the City of Sacramento; thence northerly along the easterly boundary of the City of Sacramento to its intersection with the


southerly production of the easterly boundary of Parcel No. 2 described in deed executed by Elvas Farms Company, a corporation, to American River Flood Control District, dated April 29, 1933, and recorded in the office of the Recorder of Sacramento County on May 2, 1933, in Book 430 of Official Records, at page 202; thence northerly along said southerly production and along said easterly line; thence continuing northwesterly along the northeasterly boundary of said Parcel No. 2, and its northwesterly production to the center line of the American River; thence upstream along the center line of the American River, as it exists at this date, to its intersection with the easterly production of the northerly line of said 71.25 acre tract first hereinabove referred to; thence westerly along the easterly production of said northerly boundary and continuing westerly along the northerly boundary of said 71.25 acre tract and its westerly production to the point of beginning,

be annexed to the City of Sacramento, and said City Council does hereby approve such annexation.


