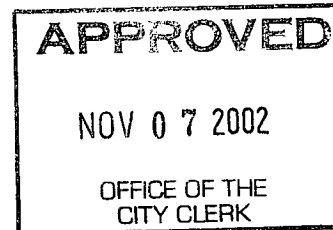

SUMMARY

The recommendation is to remove member Daniel Roth from the Human Rights/Fair Housing Commission for non-attendance having missed three consecutive meetings.

COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:

- Mr. Roth was appointed in February of 2002, to fill an unexpired term. This term will expire in December of 2003.

BACKGROUND:

- Mr Roth has been absent from three consecutive meetings of the commission. Meetings missed were the months of June, August and September. The commission did not meet during the month of July.


