RESOLUTION APPROVING PLANS & GRADES  
Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

July 8th, 1926.

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Sacramento, that the Plans presented by the City Engineer for the improvement of the westerly one-half of 53d Street, in the City of Sacramento, from the southerly line of the alley first south of "H" Street to a point 408 feet southerly therefrom, be and the same are hereby approved and adopted; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the grades shown on said plans be and the same are hereby declared to be the official grades.

# Resolution of Intention No. 2108

Pursuant to the authority of an Act of the Legislature of the State of California, known as the "Improvement Act of 1911," approved April 7th, 1911, and the several Acts amendatory thereof.

It is hereby resolved that it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Sacramento to order the following street work to be done, to-wit:

The improvement of the following in the City of Sacramento:

The westerly one-half of 53d Street, from the southerly line of the alley first south of "H" Street to a point 408 feet southerly therefrom; by removing and disposing of all surplus and refuse material; constructing concrete curb and gutter; placing cast iron street drains and connecting same to sewer system with vitrified ironstone sewer pipe; constructing vitrified ironstone pipe sewer; grading; and constructing an asphaltic concrete pavement with a seal coat.

All of said work shall be done in accordance with the detailed plans therefor adopted by the said City Council and now on file in the office of the City Engineer, and also in accordance with the "Standard Specifications for the Improvement of Streets and Alleys and for the Construction of Sewers", heretofore adopted by said City Council.

Concrete curb and gutter shall conform to Cut No. 6 of said Specifications.

Four (4) inch asphaltic concrete pavement shall be constructed as specified in Subdivisions A, B, C and D of Section 21 of said Specifications.

Seal Coat shall conform to provisions of Subdivision C of Section 22 of said Specifications.

Cast iron street drains shall conform to Cut No. 10 of said Specifications.

All persons objecting to said work, are required to file their objections in writing in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Sacramento, as required by law, and notice is hereby given to all persons interested that on the **29th** day of **July**, 1926, at **8** o'clock P. M., in the Council Chamber of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, in the City Hall, on "I" Street, between 9th and 10th Streets, in said City, any and all persons having any objections to the proposed work and improvement may appear before said City Council and show cause why the proposed work and improvement shall not be carried out in accordance with this Resolution.

And the City Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Resolution twice in the **Sacramento Union**, a daily newspaper, as required by law.
