

ORDINANCE NO. 2036, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PAINTING OF CURBS, ISSUING OF PERMITS THEREFOR; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. A householder shall be permitted to paint or cause to be painted his house number on the curb fronting his house in residential zones in accordance with the following:

The size, style and colors of numbers to be in accordance with regulations established by the Superintendent of Streets.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation engaging in the business of painting house numbers on the street curbs shall, before entering into said business, first secure from the Assessor-Collector a business license.

SECTION 3. That permits for the painting of curbs shall also be issued by the Superintendent of Streets prior to the painting of any house number on any curb within the city and that permits so issued may be revoked without notice. That said permit may be issued upon the following regulations to be kept and performed by the permittee above named:

- A. Consent must first be secured from the property owner in writing prior to the painting of any house numbers on the curb in front of his premises.
- B. That there must be a clear understanding between the permittee and the property owner on the cost of the work to be performed, prior to the time the painting is done.
- C. That after the curbs have been painted, the permittee shall give written notice to the Superintendent of streets two days after the completion of such work.
- D. That the permittee shall take out and carry, and keep in force, liability insurance against damage to property and persons by reason of the engaging in said business. That certificates of insurance must accompany the application and shall be approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.

SECTION 4. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable by a fine of not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00), or imprisonment in the City Jail for a period of not to exceed six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.


SECTION 5. Resolution No. 71, adopted by the City Council on August 28, 1930, is hereby repealed and superseded by this ordinance.

SECTION 6. This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that the City has received an application from a civic group organization for permission to paint numbers on streets and it is necessary that the regulations be specifically set out in ordinance form in order that all persons may be advised concerning the painting of house numbers on street curbs.


SECTION 7. This ordinance shall be published once within ten days after passage in the official newspaper of said City of Sacramento.
