SUBJECT: 915 K Street - Revocable Encroachment Permit

SUMMARY

Lin Hsiung Mao has applied for a Revocable Encroachment Permit for the purpose of constructing an awning over the public right-of-way at 915 K Street.

RESOLUTION GRANTING REVOCABLE ENCROACHMENT PERMIT TO:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That a Revocable Encroachment Permit for the purpose of constructing an awning over the public right-of-way at 915 K Street is hereby granted to Lin Hsiung Mao, whose address is 6715 Steamboat Way, Sacramento, California, 95831.

This encroachment is described as follows:

A 5' by 20' awning to be constructed over the full frontage of 915 K Street at a height of eight feet.

This permit is granted subject to the "General Provisions - Revocable Encroachment Permit", which were adopted by the City Council in Resolution No. 81-845 dated November 17, 1981, and the hereinafter specified special conditions, if any. This permit shall be effective only after the applicant files with the Risk Management and Insurance Division of the City of Sacramento, the insurance certificates required by the General Provisions.

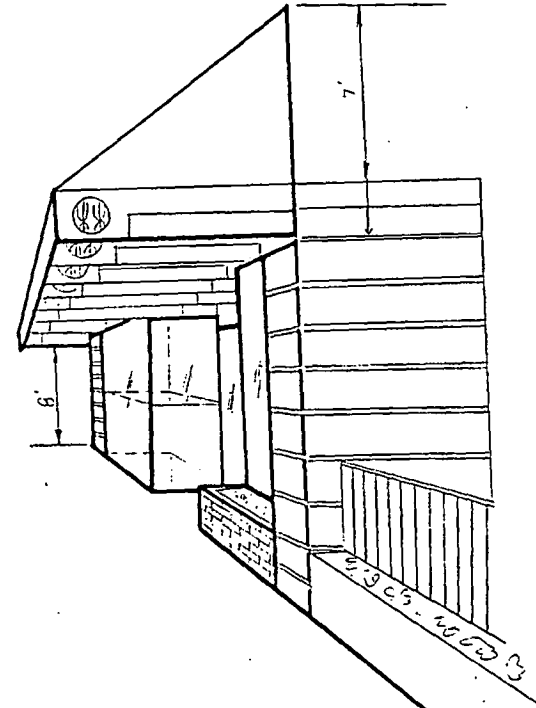
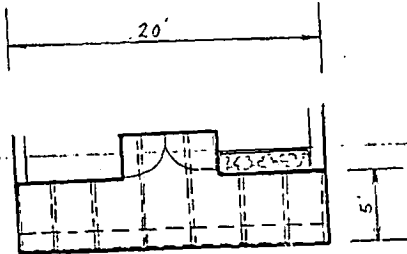
The maximum height of the sign letters is 12 inches. The awning will meet the building requirements.
