SUMMARY:

The subject project, as part of the City's Capital Improvement Program, has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and the City Engineer recommends that this report be filed pending recommendation of bid award at a later date.

On November 25, 1980 the City Council approved plans and specifications for Glenbrook Park Comfort Station and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on December 23, 1980. Bids received are as follows:
