**A RESOLUTION OF THE SACRAMENTO HOUSING
AND REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY APPROVING AND
MAKING FINDINGS REGARDING THE NEGATIVE
DECLARATION ON THE PROPOSED SIXTH AMENDMENT
TO THE ALKALI FLAT REDEVELOPMENT PLAN
REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency ("Agency"), as lead agency, has prepared a Negative Declaration (including an Initial Study/Environmental Assessment) ("Negative Declaration/Initial Study") on the proposed Sixth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Alkali Flat Redevelopment Project ("Sixth Amendment"), and;

WHEREAS, the Agency received the Negative Declaration/Initial Study and authorized its circulation and availability for public review pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA"), the State CEQA Guidelines, and City/Agency Procedures for Implementation of CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines, and;

WHEREAS, notice inviting comments on the Negative Declaration/Initial Study was published in the Sacramento Bee, a newspaper of general circulation, and mailed to all interested persons and agencies, and;

WHEREAS, following the public review and comment period, a final Negative Declaration/Initial Study was prepared incorporating comments and recommendations received on the circulated Negative Declaration/Initial Study, and responses of the Agency to environmental issues raised in the review process, and;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Section 1. The Agency hereby finds that the Negative Declaration/Initial Study has been completed in compliance with CEQA, State CEQA Guidelines and City/Agency Procedures and that the information contained in the Negative Declaration/Initial Study on the proposed Sixth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan has been reviewed by the Agency and reflects the independent judgment of the Agency.

Section 2. The Agency hereby finds, based on the Negative Declaration/Initial Study, comments received on the Negative Declaration/Initial Study and responses thereto, that there is
