

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-0243

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

June 11, 2019

Approving Renaming of Nuevo Park as Robert Brookins Park and Establishing and Funding a Capital Improvement Project for District 2 Small Projects

BACKGROUND

- A. Nuevo Park is a 6.82-acre park located at 510 Hayes Avenue in North Sacramento (Council District 2).
- B. On June 6, 2019, the Parks and Recreation Commission considered and supported the recommendation of naming Nuevo Park as Robert Brookins Park.
- C. Robert Brookins contributed significantly to the community through his artistic and cultural influence.
- D. Naming Robert Brookins Park is consistent with the City of Sacramento Facility Naming Policy adopted by the City Council on February 26, 2008 (Resolution No. 2008-0112).
- E. Utilizing funds from the Park Impact Fee Fund (Fund 3204) is appropriate for the costs of the new park sign and plaque.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The change in the park name of Nuevo Park to “Robert Brookins Park” is hereby approved.
- Section 2. The City Manager or the City Manager’s designee is authorized to establish District 2 Small Projects Capital Improvement Project as L19114200.

Section 3. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to appropriate \$20,000 from the Park Impact Fee Available Fund Balance (Fund 3204) to the District 2 Small Projects Capital Improvement Project (L19114200).
