# Resolution

of the City Council

## Recognizing Frank C. Freer

**W**HEREAS, Frank Freer moved to Sacramento in 1925 when he was seven years old and is a graduate of Grant Union High School where he played on the golf team; and

**W**HEREAS, Frank started his golf career as a caddie at the Del Paso Country Club when he was fourteen years old, joined the Sacramento Golf Club at Haggin Oaks in 1946, and actively participated in club activities by serving as club Secretary and later as club President (1950-51) and still maintains his Sacramento Golf Club membership; and

**W**HEREAS, in 1951, Frank joined the Sacramento Golf Council and continues to serve as an active member after 47 years (having served 2 terms as President) and is possibly best known for his service as the director of the California State Fair Championship which he has directed since 1952; and

**W**HEREAS, in 1963, Frank Freer served as Chairman of the National Men's Public Links Championship held at Haggin Oaks Golf Course, was selected by the United States Golf Association (USGA) to serve as the Sectional Qualifying Committeeman for the National Public Links and has served on the Northern California Golf Association (NCGA) Board of Directors for six years working numerous NCGA golf tournament events including the State Amateur Championship; and

**W**HEREAS, Frank has dedicated a good portion of his life to golf in Sacramento and Northern California bringing organization and professionalism to every aspect of golf.

**N**OW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Sacramento, that we do hereby commend Frank C. Freer for his dedication and commitment to the game of golf resulting in numerous and untold contributions to the community and do hereby wish him continued success in future endeavors.
