FOSTER GRANDPARENT AND SENIOR
COMPANION PROGRAM CONTINUATION
APPLICATIONS AND CONTRACTS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF
SACRAMENTO:

Section 1. The Executive Director is authorized to submit proposals to the Federal ACTION agency for continuation funding for the Sacramento Foster Grandparent Program in the amount of \$143,341 and the Sacramento Senior Companion Program in the amount of \$31,526.


Section 2. The Executive Director is authorized to submit proposals to the California Department of Aging for continuation funding for the Sacramento Foster Grandparent Program in the amount of \$22,758 and the Sacramento Senior Companion Program in the amount of \$62,250.

Section 3. (a) The Agency Community Services Division budget for 1984 is amended to include the appropriations for the Foster Grandparent and Senior Companion Program (Organization 3800), which is \$621,168. The 1984 Agency budget is as follows:

(b) The additional estimated revenues of \$259,875 that are forthcoming from the Federal ACTION Agency and California Department of Aging will be accounted for in the Foster Grandparent and Senior Companion Program.

Section 4. The Executive Director is authorized to execute contracts with the Federal ACTION Agency and California Department of Aging upon receipt of award of funds for the programs.
