SUBJECT: 1729 L Street - Revocable Encroachment Permit

SUMMARY

That a Revocable Encroachment Permit for the purpose of installing a 17'x 3' wide canopy is hereby granted to the Himovitz/Jensen Gallery whose address is 1729 L Street, Sacramento, California.

This encroachment is described as follows:

A three feet by seventeen feet encroachment of canopy along the south side of L Street adjacent to 1729 L Street at a height of eight feet.

This permit is granted subject to the "General Provisions - Revocable Encroachment Permit", which were adopted by the City Council in Resolution No. 81-845 dated November 17, 1981. This permit shall be effective only after the applicant files with the Risk Management and Insurance Division of the City of Sacramento, the insurance certificates required by the General Provisions.
