

# RESOLUTION No. 65

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

RESOLUTION APPROVING LEASE OF THE CALIFORNIA TRANSPORTATION COMPANY WHARF AND THE OPEN WHARF ON THE WATER FRONT TO THE RIVER LINES.

WHEREAS, the lease heretofore granted to The River Lines of the wharves on the water front has expired, and

WHEREAS, after report from the City Manager and hearings had thereon, the City Council has agreed to make a new lease to The River Lines of the wharf known as the California Transportation Company Wharf and the open wharf for a period of one year at the rental of \$200.00 per month with a \$500.00 remission of the debt of The River Lines to the City, and


WHEREAS, a lease has been prepared embodying terms satisfactory both to the City and to The River Lines, which is presented herewith,
