

ORDINANCE NO. 1565, FOURTH SERIES.

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO HAVE CERTAIN WORK OF DRILLING A WELL FOR THE SACRAMENTO MUNICIPAL GOLF COURSE IN DEL PASO PARK DONE AND TO HIRE AND CONTRACT FOR THE SERVICES OF INSTALLATION OF SAID WELL, WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to have certain work of drilling a well for the Sacramento Municipal Golf Course in Del Paso Park done and to hire and contract for the services of installation of said well, without first advertising for bids, pursuant to Section 251 of the City Charter. Said well to be 14" in diameter with a 10 gauge hard steel casing to a depth of 200 feet and to develop 1600 gallons of water per minute. The estimated cost of said well to be \$4500.00.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that the land upon which the former well was located is being taken over by the State of California for highway purposes and it is necessary to drill a new well as quickly as possible to replace it.


