Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

March 22, 1940

RESOLUTION RESTORING ASSESSMENT TO DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS INSTEAD OF "PAID"

WHEREAS, under and by virtue of Resolution of Intention No. 2213, passed and adopted by the City Council of the City of Sacramento on November 10, 1927, an improvement of Land Park Drive was ordered, as provided in the "Improvement Act of 1911" and "Improvement Bond Act of 1915," and after due proceedings had therefor there was assessed for the payment of said improvement the sum of \$2029.26 against certain property described as

Triangular tract bounded: N-by "Y" St. (or Broadway); W-by Lots 22 and 23 "Swanston Park, Unit No. 1" (as the same is shown on the official map or plat thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California); and third side-by Land Park Drive,

which said assessment was not paid and which became delinquent; and


WHEREAS, by mistake and inadvertence and improperly marked "Paid" on the records in the office of the Superintendent of Streets, although the same was never paid and is now due and entirely delinquent;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the entry purporting to show that said assessment has been paid be removed and deleted from the said records; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that said assessment be collected, or the said property sold to the City of Sacramento under the terms of said "Improvement Bond Act of 1915."
