ORDINANCE NO. 1206, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 16 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1066, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JULY 10, 1945, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND WAGES OF ALL EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, AND PROVIDING RULES FOR THE DETERMINATION THEREOF; REPEALING ORDINANCES NOS. 1026, 1031, 1045, 1052, 1053 AND 1065, RESPECTIVELY, OF THE FOURTH SERIES, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY," BY AMENDING SUBDIVISION "CRAFTS AND LABOR," AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Section 16 of Ordinance No. 1066, Fourth Series, is hereby amended by amending Subdivision "CRAFTS AND LABOR:"

CRAFTS AND LABOR

1	Electrician	\$1.87½ per hour
1	Electrician, Lineman	\$1.87½ per hour
1	Electrician, Apprentice	\$1.50 per hour
1	Electrician, Foreman	\$2.00 per hour

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that it is necessary that the salary adjustment provided for herein become effective immediately.
