Bike Commute Week May 18-22, 1998

WHEREAS, the bicycle is a fun, safe and environmentally sound form of transportation and an excellent form of recreation; and

WHEREAS, millions of Americans will experience the joys of bicycling in May through educational programs, commuting events, trail work days, helmet promotions, and recreational and charity rides; and

WHEREAS, Americans in record numbers are turning to bicycling for recreation, exercise, and transportation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento adopted the 2010 Sacramento City/County Bicycle Advisory Committee to advise it on implementation of the Bikeway Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Area Bicycle Advocates in cooperation with bicycle riding clubs and other interested groups have sponsored Bike to Work Day since 1991.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Joe Serna, Jr., Mayor of the City of Sacramento, do hereby proclaim the week of May 18, 1998 as **Bike Commute Week**, encourage education about and enforcement of traffic safety laws as they apply to bicycles, and encourage City employees to utilize bicycling as an alternative mode of transportation for commuting and work-related activities.
