I. CALL TO ORDER: At the hour of 4:10, the meeting was called to order by Wayne Cook.

IV. DISCUSSION:

4a. The Cultural Resource Directory supplemental pages have reached the schools, some have called to report that they do not have the original directory sent out to them in the fall of 92. Staff recommends that we send an annual directory in the beginning of the school year with a supplement in January or February.

4b. Virgin In A Sense negotiations are pending for touring to other high schools. There also is a possibility of recreating the project at Hiram Johnson High School. UCDCMC, the artists and playwright are eager to start. Need to hear from the Prevention program for SCUSD.

4c. The Alamo Rent A Car Children's Art project is progressing. Airport officials and architects have researched wall possibilities for a safe hanging system. System will be a retail-type paneling with built-in grooves to allow for vertical and horizontal placement of art work. The airport is considering having two spaces to show four schools per month, approx. 40 pieces of work.

4d. Technical Assistance workshop on Dec. 2nd for artist and interested sponsors in the Artist in Residence program of the CAC for Feb. 11, 1994 deadline applications will be distributed and a mock panel with past artists and panel members will take place.

4e. NEA panel will review our grant Dec. 2nd and 3rd. Site visitor Nada Westerman was impressed with our programs. She met with school officials, community leaders, commissioners and artists, had a full day of touring to sites, attended dress rehearsal for the rap opera, mural project in Oak Park and a reception with artists from the community.

4f. Meetings for the months of January and February have been changed to the 4th Monday of the month because of the holidays falling on the committees meeting dates.

The "Virgin In A Sense" rap opera video was shown.
