A letter was received from City Manager James S. Dean regarding the eligibility of Harry Forward, Dave Washington, and John Washington as to their legal residence within the limits of the City of Sacramento. Mr. Dean, together with Mr. McQuillan, Cronin and Mr. John Garibaldi were in attendance to offer evidence to show that these men were not bona fide residence of the City of Sacramento. Mr. Luke Howe was also in attendance to represent as council the three men in question. After considerable discussion, Commissioner Maloney moved that the matter be referred back to Mr. Dean for handling without any recommendation. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Chenu. The vote was as follows:

NOES: None. ABSENT: Commissioner Weisman.



AYES: Commissioners Maloney and Chenu.


NOES: None.
