SUBJECT: CONSULTANT SERVICES CONTRACT WITH THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE PLANNING

SUMMARY

In December, 1981, the City of Sacramento contracted with the Office of Criminal Justice Planning to provide the services of a Law Enforcement Consultant for a period of one year. It has been requested that this contract be amended to extend the period of performance through June 30, 1983 and to provide for extension of the program in one year increments.

BACKGROUND

Officer Mathew Powers has, since the initiation of this contract, provided the expertise required to develop and implement training programs for the Career Criminal Apprehension Program (CCAP) Grants being awarded to local law enforcement agencies, and for the administration and evaluation of these programs. It is considered desirable to retain the continuity of this program by allowing Officer Powers to continue in this capacity for the period specified.

FINANCIAL DATA

Authorization to extend this program will require augmentation of the Police Department budget for Fiscal Year 1982-83 to include one police officer for six months and increase appropriations for Employee Services by \$20,864.84. All anticipated costs for this program will be offset by a corresponding increase in revenues from the State of California. The cost and associated revenue for each renewable option will be established prior to implementation and will be predicated on the guidelines for the budget period impacted.


RECOMMENDATION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

The Sacramento Police Department desires to continue providing the services of a Law Enforcement Consultant to the Office of Criminal Justice Planning for the purpose of providing technical assistance to California law enforcement agencies and aiding in the development and administration of the Career Criminal Apprehension Program.

In the event said agency consents to amend the contract for such services, the City Manager is authorized, on behalf of the City Council, to execute the contract amendment covering the period December 28, 1982 through June 30, 1983 with renewable options in one year increments.

The Sacramento Police Department budget for Fiscal Year 1982-83 is to be increased by \$20,864.84. Appropriations in this amount are to be credited to Account 1-01-1710-5183-41xx.

The source of funds shall be the Administrative Contingency Fund of the General Fund, Account 1-01-5070-0000-4399.

Revenues from said contract with the Office of Criminal Justice Planning shall be deposited to the General Fund Account 1-01-0000-5183-3608.
