



Here are documents for ETL on the spray booth. Sorry that it took an extra day as we have move our plant to a new building, and some of the paperwork was not readily available.

Hope this helps.

As you can see, the Spray booth was tested for ETL on July 6, 2003. A letter report was issued #3045447.LO1.

We have just recently sent an \*electrical box with the new computer control relay, same brand of relay as the old one, like the one on Peter Burn's unit, to ETL for a complete humidity-conditioning test. This test should be 24 hours in a humidity chamber to see how the materials hold up. The components should hold up very well and we don't see there being any problems with this.

The problem would be after the humidity test, ETL normally takes 4-6 weeks to issue paper work. We will try to get them to expedite this as soon as possible. If Mr. Burns could open now and run the unit with the paperwork provided, we could change the unit's electric box and/or components after the results from the humidity test is completed. If there are any changes that the humidity test requires we will install a new electric box with the appropriate changes.

Or we could install a new electrical box from the factory and/or components what ever you like us to do.

To help satisfy Mr. Burns, we told him we would pay his interest for his loan for this equipment for one (1) month. The only problem with this is, he wants more money because of business lost. We are not sure about this?

Mr. Burns has already called the lease company. The lease is non-refundable so we want to help to satisfy you to help Mr. Burns open quickly. So if there is anything you can do to help it would be appreciated.

On July 22-24, 2003, Intertek engineer, Brett Aisop, evaluated your MegaMist Spray Mist Tan Booth at your St. Louis facility. The unit was evaluated for compliance with the applicable requirements of the Standard for Personal Hygiene and Health Care Appliances (UL 1432, 2<sup>nd</sup> Edition (rev 8/4/98)) and Electromedical Equipment (CSA C22.2 No. 125-M1984 (rev 11/96)).

The units evaluated are misting booths for application of spray tan solution. The unit is cord connected to the supply source.

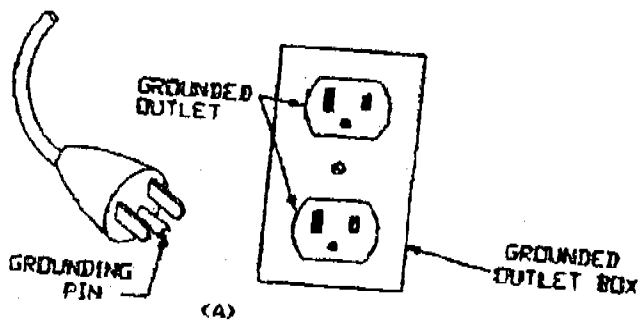


