

ORDINANCE NO. 1204, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF AUTOMOBILES ON THE OPEN MARKET WITHOUT RE-ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

WHEREAS, on the 5th day of July, 1946, the City Council duly adopted Specifications for the furnishing of automobiles to the City of Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, after due advertisement of a notice requesting bids according to said specifications, no bids were received which conform to said specifications,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That the City is hereby authorized to purchase five (5) automobiles on the open market without re-advertising for bids.

SECTION 2: The automobiles purchased pursuant to the authority of this ordinance shall be according to the specifications previously advertised and referred to herein.

SECTION 3: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the immediate necessity of replacing certain automotive equipment in order to carry on the functions of city government.
