RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITY OPERATING BUDGET
FOR FY 1984-85 FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

1. That a poster of a Sacramento History Center mural is to be designed and camera ready for printing;
2. That the City operating budget for FY 1984-85 is hereby amended:
 - a. by adding thereto the sum of \$2,500 to the Museum and History Division budget 1-01-4651-0000-4258 relating to the expenditure of funds for the design work of the poster;
 - b. that the above appropriation increase is supported by revenue forthcoming from the Sacramento History Center, Inc.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE
AN AGREEMENT WITH FRANK CARSON DESIGN
FOR THE POSTER DESIGN

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement between Frank Carson Design and the City of Sacramento for the purpose of designing a camera-ready poster of a mural located in the Sacramento History Center.

AGREEMENT

This Agreement made as of _____, by and between the City of Sacramento, a municipal corporation ("City"), and Frank Carson Design ("FCD"), who agree as follows:

1. Subject to the terms and conditions set forth herein, FCD will execute camera-ready art in the form of a poster (the "art") to be used by City's Museum and History Division. The art will be painted in full color and shall be developed from a composite image supplied by City. The art shall be signed by Frank Carson, in accordance with FCD's policies related to original Frank Carson work. FCD shall furnish at its own expense all supplies and materials needed to complete the art.

2. FCD shall retain ownership of the original camera-ready art.

3. City shall own the copyright to the art and all reproduction rights connected with the art. FCD shall not reproduce or use the original camera-ready art, except with written permission from City first obtained.

4. City shall pay to FCD the sum of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500) for execution of the art. Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500) shall be paid upon execution of this contract, and Five Thousand (\$5,000) shall be paid upon City's acceptance of the camera-ready art. Sales tax, if applicable, will be payable by City.

5. FCD shall be an independent contractor and not an employee of City. City shall have the right to control FCD only in regard to the results of FCD's services rendered pursuant to this agreement and

shall not have the right to control the means by which FCD
accomplishes the services. FCD shall obtain approvals from City's
Executive Director of the Museum and History Division or his designee
upon completion of the line drawing for the art and upon completion
of the camera-ready art.
