

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING

RECOMMENDED DECISION OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE - ROBERT SANCHEZ

Ms. Mabbutt, for the record, informed the Board that she listened to the tape of the May 7, 1985 Board Meeting on May 16, 1985.

Mr. Richard Antoine, Deputy City Attorney, addressed the Board. He passed out proposed decisions and minutes from the Civil Service Board pertaining to the cases of Mario Betti and Antonio Sanchez for the Board's information.

Mr. Lyle R. Nishimi, Attorney representing Robert Sanchez addressed the Board. Mr. Sanchez was in attendance.

Mr. Nishimi objected to Mr. Antoine's passing out material on other cases. He stated that the Board should make their decision on the material presented in this case only.

A motion was made that the Board accept the past decisions and minutes of

the proceedings in the Mario Betti and Antonio Sanchez cases for informational purposes only.

RECOMMENDED DECISION OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE - RONALD VANCE

Mr. Sam Jackson, Deputy City Attorney, addressed the Board and urged them to adopt the recommended decision of the Administrative Law Judge.

Mr. Garland Rosauo addressed the Board and informed them that Mr. Ronald Vance was present and wished to address them on his own behalf.

Mr. Vance informed the Board that he felt he was not represented properly

and was not given the chance to subpoena more witnesses or speak in his own behalf.

Mr. Rosauo told the Board that Mr. Vance was given full opportunity to request any witnesses he wanted to be subpoenaed.

Mr. Jackson informed the Board that Mr. Vance was put on the witness stand and that was his opportunity to inform the Judge of any information he had pertinent to his letter of reprimand.

After considerable discussion a motion was made to adopt the findings of fact, the determination of issues and the proposed decision of the Administrative Law Judge.
