WINFIELD L. BOGUE
Re: Position on Eligible Register

A letter from Winfield L. Bogue dated February 27, 1946, requesting information as to his status on the Patrolman Eligible Register #128 was read. Mr. Bogue informed the Board that he had joined the Royal Air Force in September 1941 and transferred to the American Air Force in September 1942. After review and discussion, it was the finding of the Civil Service Board, conditioned upon proper documental verification, that Mr. Bogue's name be placed on a Military List, which took precedence over the Patrolman Eligible Register No. 165 and records indicate that he had been reached in certification and therefore his name shall be placed at the proper level at the top of a new eligible register for Patrolman when established.
