

RESOLUTION No. 25

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

January 19, 1940

WHEREAS, the sixteenth national census is now being taken by the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census, throughout the United States; and


WHEREAS, the period from January 1st to March 31st has been designated as the time to conduct the business census, to be followed during the period from April 1st to June 30th by the population, housing, and agricultural census; and

WHEREAS, the business census now in progress will provide a wealth of vital statistics of tremendous value dealing with employment trends, labor turnover, sales volume, etc. without disclosing the details of operation of any single business concern;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that every citizen of Sacramento, and particularly those engaged in business enterprises of every kind, be urged to extend their earnest and whole-hearted cooperation to the Department of Commerce, Bureau of The Census, in providing all the necessary information for the proper conduct of the business census now in progress, and the population, housing and agricultural census which will immediately follow.
