

ORDINANCE NO. 2045, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 126 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1570, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED MARCH 8, 1951, AND ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC, TRAVEL, AND PARKING UPON THE STREETS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES LAID OUT FOR THE USE OF VEHICLES AND PEDESTRIANS IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO. DEFINING THE TERMS USED IN THIS ORDINANCE, CREATING CERTAIN TRAFFIC DISTRICTS IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, FIXING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 304, FOURTH SERIES, AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. Section 126 of Ordinance No. 1570, Fourth Series, passed March 8, 1951, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 126, EFFECT OF ORDINANCE. a. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of this ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional.

b. Any provision of this ordinance which regulates traffic or delegates the regulation of traffic upon state highways in any way for which the approval of the Department of Public Works is required by state law, shall cease to be operative six months after receipt by the City Council of written notice of withdrawal of approval of the Department of Public Works.


c. Whenever this ordinance delegates authority to a city officer, or authorizes action by the City Council to regulate traffic upon a state highway in any way which by state law requires the prior approval of the Department of Public Works, no such officer shall exercise such authority nor shall such action by the City Council be effective with respect to any state highway without the prior approval in writing of the Department of Public Works when and to the extent required by Division 9 and Division 11 of the Vehicle Code.


SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be published once within 10 days after passage in the official newspaper of said City of Sacramento.
