Summary:

The City of Sacramento uses the services of the Office of Administrative Hearings for appeals of decision for suspending, demoting, or dismissing an officer or employee, and denying an application of any retirement benefit or allowance.

Background Information:

The City of Sacramento routinely uses Administrative Law Judges to hear appeals for the Civil Service Board and for Industrial Disability Retirement appeals. For many years, the City has had a contract with the Office of Administrative Hearings to provide for Administrative Law Judges. This contract will bring the amount to over \$100,000 that has been paid over the years.

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH STATE OF CALIFORNIA, OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS TO PROVIDE FOR ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGES.

BACKGROUND

- A. The City of Sacramento routinely utilizes the Office of Administrative Hearings to provide Administrative Law Judges to conduct hearings and issue proposed decisions;
- B. The Department of Human Resources has sufficient funds to pay for these services in their budget.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute an agreement with the State of California, Office of Administrative Hearings to provide for Administrative Law Judges for an amount not to exceed \$25,000.
