SUBJECT: Resolution Appropriating Funds and Recommendation of Bid Award for Sewer and Water Reconstruction Project at "S" and "T" Alley Between 5th and 6th Streets

SUMMARY:

The subject project, as approved by the City Council, has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and the City Engineer hereby recommends bid award.

BACKGROUND:

On January 27, 1981, the Budget and Finance Committee approved plans and specifications for the Sewer and Water Reconstruction project at "S" and "T" Alley between 5th and 6th Streets with an estimated cost of \$88,272.91 and accepted the staff recommendation to appropriate the funds upon receipt of bids. On February 10, 1981, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for the project and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on March 3, 1981. Bids received are as follows:

FINANCIAL:

It is proposed that funding for water reconstruction be provided from the Water Fund balance in the amount of \$12,338.00. It is also proposed that funding for the sewer reconstruction portion be provided from the Sewer Fund balance in the amount of \$51,000.00. Sufficient unappropriated funds are available in each fund balance to permit such appropriations.

RECOMMENDATION:

The City Engineer recommends that:


