

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-594

**SUSPENDING COMPETITIVE SELECTION FOR STUDENT INTERN SERVICES AND
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A SOLE
SOURCE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE COMMUNITY
COLLEGE FOUNDATION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$210,000**

BACKGROUND

- A. The Department of General Services has a need for temporary administrative and technical support, and the use of student interns provides flexibility in meeting service demand levels.
- B. The student intern program through the Community College Foundation is a cost-effective means of obtaining temporary administrative and technical support.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. It is in the best interest of the City to suspend competitive selection for student intern services and competitive selection is hereby suspended, and

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a sole source professional services agreement with the Community College Foundation in an amount not to exceed \$210,000.




