

ORDINANCE NO. 1546, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE AMOUNT OF PERMIT FEES FOR THE CUTTING OF CURBS FOR ACCESS DRIVEWAYS TO PRIVATE PROPERTY AND FIXING A PENALTY FOR CUTTING A CURB WITHOUT A PERMIT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. All persons, firms or corporations installing and maintaining a means of vehicular access from the abutting public right of way to their property shall, prior to construction of such driveway, apply for a permit and pay an inspection fee therefor. A fee to cover the inspection costs shall be charged as follows:

a. For driveways not more than 15 feet in length, a fee of \$1.00.

b. For driveways more than 15 feet long, the base fee in (a) shall be increased by fifty cents for each five feet or fraction thereof of driveway length in excess of 15 feet. In the case of multiple driveways serving the same property and constructed under one permit the aggregate length of all driveways shall be used in computing the fee.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to construct and/or reconstruct a ~~curb~~ ~~or~~ driveway upon the public right-of-way within the City of Sacramento without first obtaining a permit therefor as above outlined.


SECTION 3. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00, or by imprisonment in the City Jail of the City of Sacramento not to exceed six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
